| Affirmative                  | Negative                      | Questions                     |
|------------------------------|-------------------------------|-------------------------------|
| subject + <b>will</b> + verb | subject + <b>won't</b> + verb | <b>Will</b> + subject + verb? |
| I will create a new recipe.  | I won't eat chocolate.        | Will you use the internet?    |




